To find out how Blackboard works, go here. Click on Blackboard Practice Site on the right side of the page under Course Catalog, click on the Course ID (DEV_A_BBPRACTICE). This will give you limited access to the practice site. You can see more features if you have a UMS Id by self-enrolling in the practice course:

- Log into <u>Blackboard</u>, (see <u>video tutorial</u> on logging in)
- Clicking on the Courses tab
- Click on Blackboard Practice Site

Textbooks: Textbooks are available from the USM Portland campus bookstore or through the UM Augusta bookstore. Textbooks for courses originating from Lewiston Auburn College (HUM, LAC, LCC LOS, SBS) and taught by LAC faculty are physically housed in the LAC bookstore only but may still be purchased online through the USM Bookstores website (see below). Payment options include cash, USM Card, VISA, MASTERCARD, DISCOVER CARD, and personal checks. A picture ID and your student ID number are required for check purchases. Used textbooks cost 30% less than new texts and are available for most courses.

How to Order Textbooks: You may order by phone, e-mail or online. The cost of each order will include a shipping and handling fee determined by the total cost of your order.

Technology Requirements: To access your online course, you will need a relatively new computer with an up to date web browser. Depending on individual course delivery methods, high speed internet access may be a requirement for your course in order to access many of the larger media files that are prevalent in today's online education community. You may also need free media plug-ins such as Quicktime or Flash, or a software MP3 player. Your instructor may also require specific software to use for completing assignments, or require that assignments be submitted in certain file formats. Read your instructor's requirements carefully. There are rarely requirements that you purchase specific software on your own.

Your UMaine System account: If you are a student new to the University of Maine System, you will need to activate your System account. (For an explanation of this account, see http://usm.maine.edu/computing/networking/ums_accounts.jsp) Before a University of Maine System account can be used for any purpose, it must be activated through the website at http://mail.maine.edu. (Choose Account Activation.) To activate your account, you will need your Student Identification Number and your account Activation Key. After clicking on the login button, use your University of Maine System User ID and password which must be activated before using. Parking: If you are taking only blended or online courses (i.e. you are not taking any inclassroom courses) you will NOT be automatically charged a Transportation Fee, and therefore will not have access to parking on campus. For your convenience, however, you may purchase a parking decal for your vehicle by visiting the Parking Office, located on the ground level of the Abromson Community Center on the Portland campus. Decals cost \$44.00 per semester. Alternatively, you can park in the Abromson parking garage for \$1.00/hour. Parking on the Lewiston-Auburn Campus is free of charge, so if you only need to park on the Lewiston-Auburn

Campus, you will not need to purchase a decal. The Parking office can be reached at 207-780-4718.
